



On Saturday, at 4:00pm, in the Federal room, Alix Wright will conduct the Main Ritual, which is an Ostara ritual that will celebrate Spring, and to help each of us prepare our way through the Season of Light ahead.

This Ostara ritual celebrates the Vernal Equinox—the moment of balance between light and dark—and honors the awakening of the land as the Wheel turns toward growth. The rite centers on themes of equilibrium, renewal, and intentional beginnings, acknowledging that fertility and expansion arise from a poised midpoint rather than excess. Participants gather to mark the equal day and night, recognizing both what has been endured through winter and what is now ready to emerge.

Fires of the Queer Spirit *with Wrentek McGowan*

This is an experience for people who self-identify as queer to share sacred space with each other, and with Queer Spirit. We will share, as we are moved, about our own experience of queerness, and commune with Queer Spirit for healing and inspiration. If you identify as queer, you are welcome. Including, but certainly not limited to gay, lesbian, bisexual, pansexual, transgender, non-binary, polyamorous, asexual, aromantic, and more.

After Dark — Superstitions in Sacred Sexuality (The Sacred, The Profane, The Taboo) *with Wrentek McGowan*

Join me for a lively discussion surrounding the Superstitions in Sacred Sexuality and how we define the Sacred, the Profane and the Taboo. We will explore the intersectionality of these topics and how they relate to Sacred Sexuality. Must be over the age of 18. Please be prepared to discuss topics of sex and of a sexual nature. There will be no nudity or sexual contact in this class.

The Magic of Numbers *with Kirk White*

Since before Pythagoras, numbers have been considered of great magical power. This class will introduce students to the traditional magic of numbers - especially as practiced prior to the 20th century. Learn how to use them to better understand your world and become an active force in co-creating your reality.

Old School Warding: Medieval Apotropaic Magic *with Kirk White*

The world is filled with spirits and forces - not all of them benign. Our ancestors had a number of tools and tricks they employed to turn away and protect against such

forces. Learn a number of simple yet effective symbols, tools and practices to keep off unwanted influences.

A Special Place, A Special Year: Creating a Local Sacred Year *with Kirk White*

While many of us are familiar with the standard eight holidays of the Wiccan/ Neo-Pagan year, for some of us it doesn't actually fit our local climates. Spring does not begin in February or March in Vermont. This class will explore creating more locally oriented holidays and sacred traditions.

Light, Color, and Shape: Intuitive Reading of Oracle Cards *with Sophia Kelly Shultz*

The art on Oracle cards is often breathtaking and often daunting to interpret. Sure, it's easy enough to read the book and see what the author says—or doesn't say—it's easy to look at the main elements and draw meaning from, but is it possible you could be missing something?

This workshop presents the participant with a new set of suggestions for the “first blush” reading of cards. By integrating the basics of the cards and demonstrates just how much light, color, and shape can influence interpretation of a reading.

After Dark — Just The Facts, Ma'at: Ancient Egyptian Magic, Plain and Simple *with Sophia Kelly Shultz*

Just as the wonders of ancient Egyptian culture need no embellishment, the complex and fascinating magical practices of the ancient Egyptians do not need the imaginative embellishments envisioned by modern authors and practitioners. This workshop explores the core concepts surrounding ancient Egyptian magic, providing information about core beliefs and practices that spanned the 30 centuries of ancient Egyptian civilization.

Colonial New England Superstitions & The Threads of Folk Magic *with Roxie Zwicker*

Fears in a dark new world shaped the early days of the New England colonies. Were dramatic moments in history shaped by luck, the devil, or a vengeful God? Could a bit of homespun folkways counter the biggest challenges people experienced and are the echoes of those stories still haunting us from the basements and within the walls

of our oldest places? Folklorist and author Roxie Zwicker spins a curious history of Colonial rituals and rites that shaped not only the past but also the present.

Victorian Superstitions & The Threads of Life & Death *with Roxie Zwicker*

The 19th century was a time when superstitions crept from the shadows and dwelled in the light prompting curious souls to speak with the dead both as a party game and as a soothing balm for a grieving soul. In this session explore the methods and meanings of Victorian superstitions in New England. From seances, poison gardens, burial customs and curiosity cabinets discover the magic the Victorian age holds for the modern day practitioner.

Herbal Myth, Magick, and Medicine: Folklore as a Guide to the Wild *with Sha Blackburn*

Have you ever wondered if there is truth behind the “old wives’ tales” of the plant kingdom? Beyond the garden gate lies a world of ancient wisdom waiting to be rediscovered. In this immersive workshop, we peel back the layers of folklore to reveal the potent healing and magickal properties of common plants growing right beneath our feet.

Whether you are meeting these plants for the first time or looking to deepen an existing practice, this session bridges the gap between ancient myth and modern application. We will explore how traditional lore serves as a practical map for identification, ethical harvesting, and ritual use. Join us to transform “weeds” into allies, reclaim your heritage, and turn every walk into a journey of discovery.

An Introduction to Augury: Deciphering the Signs All Around You *with Sha Blackburn*

The universe isn’t silent; it’s just waiting for you to learn the language. For millennia, our ancestors looked to the flight of birds, the shift of the wind, and the sudden patterns of the natural world to navigate their most vital decisions. This wasn’t superstition—it was Augury, the sophisticated art of interpreting the “conversation” between the seeker and the divine.

In this experiential workshop, we are pulling this ancient practice out of the history books and putting it squarely into your modern life. We’re moving past the vague “coincidences” and getting down to the brass tacks of spiritual communication.

Seeking the Crone *with Matooka Moonbear*

In the craft of the wise we often hear reference to Crone as an aspect of the triplicity of Goddess. In ancient cultures, there was a place of power for the Crone – the elder woman who knows. In present day society, there does not seem to be a space of honor for elders. The truth is the gift of the Crone is as valuable now as it has ever been...perhaps more so! This workshop invites all people who are interested to know Crone and her gifts. We explore her through discussion and a meditative journey.

Serpent Magick *with Matooka Moonbear*

Working with snakes as a spirit ally for shedding what we are ready to release, taking in what we desire as a whole and digesting the magick to manifest life.

Story-Stone Bag Children's Ritual *with J.C. Artemisia*

Through a simplified form of lithomancy, children will engage in age-appropriate energy building and empowering intention practice as they draw painted stones and interpret messages.

The Weaver's Secret Children's Mythology Workshop *with J.C.*

Artemisia

Children

will be read an abridged version of the Athena/ Arachne story (with focus on the skill and artistry theme rather than jealousy and punishment elements). Afterward, kids will explore magical color association, age-appropriate weaving technique options, and building intentions into their craft.

Crow Medicine: Keeper of Truth, Guardian of Shadow, Midwife of Light *with Diana Harris*

For centuries, Crow has been feared, misunderstood, and wrapped in superstition — cast as harbinger, trickster, omen of doom, or symbol of darkness. Yet in indigenous wisdom traditions, shamanic cultures, and many Wiccan and Pagan magical systems, Crow carries far deeper medicine: truth-telling, spiritual sight, boundary-keeping between worlds, and fierce guardianship of transformation. Through story, reflection, and a compassionate weaving of shamanic, Wiccan, and psycho-spiritual understanding, we'll reclaim Crow as a sacred companion in times of uncertainty, magic, grief, transition, and rebirth.

Spell Oils 101 — Make & Take *with Kate Holly-Clark*

Make a couple of basic spell oils and learn some safety tips for mixing your own.

This is a class in mixing some basic spell oils and is hands on. We will be emphasizing some of the practical as well as the mystical aspects— how to handle essential oils safely, proper dilution, mixing, and decanting into rollerball bottles. We will make at least two oils in class and each student will be able to take their rollerball bottles with them. 
